



## 2021 FEE STRUCTURE: PSI AND PSI ASSESSMENTS

### Annual psi Registration and Development Fees

This registration and development fee covers the work of the IEB assessment specialists as well as development work that the IEB undertakes. All annual psi registration fees are payable on registration as a psi school.

Annual Registration Fee: stand-alone primary school	R4 035
